Defense of Shu Lin on "Efficient Model Predictive Control for Large-Scale Urban Traffic Networks.

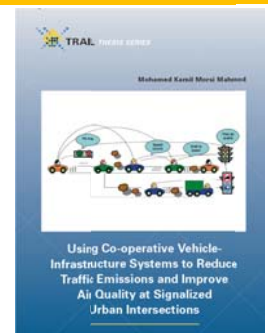
The defense will be on April 19 next, 12.30 hrs @ Delft University of Technology, Senaatzaal, Aula.

Mohamed Mahmod (UT) on "Using Co-Operative Vehicle-Infrastructure Systems to Reduce Traffic Emissions and Improve Air Quality at Signalized Urban Intersections". The thesis gives more insight into the impacts of co-operative vehicle-infrastructure systems on the environment. Results show that traffic emissions can be reduced at signalized intersections using Infrastructure-to-Vehicle communication to influence drivers' behaviour in real-time.
