TRAVEL SIMULATOR EXPERIMENT

Invitation travel simulator experiment – Part 2: Online Sessions by TRAIL PhD student

Do you travel from home to work or study by car, at least one day a week, and are you able to read in Dutch? If yes, I would like to invite you to participate in the Part 2- the online sessions - of the travel simulator experiment that will start within a week. The experiment is part of an NWO-sponsored PhD-project into how commuters substitute between different commuting options and various forms of ICT (travel information, teleworking).

In the experiment, participants will be asked to make a number of choices in a virtual (hypothetical) travel environment. Afterwards, participants will be asked to fill out a brief survey. The entire experiment will take 45 minutes maximum (averagely 30 minutes) and participants can do the experiment online. Upon finishing the experiment, you will receive a monetary reward which will depend on the choices made during the experiment (the minimum reward equals €10, the maximum reward equals €25).
