**Eureka Prize for Science Communication**

The Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW) and the Netherlands Organisation for Scientific Research (NWO) have awarded the joint Eureka Prize for Science Communication for the first time in 2012.

In awarding this prize, the two organisations are joining forces to promote public awareness of science and public access to scientific knowledge and understanding. From 2012 onwards, the Eureka Prize will be awarded annually to both a scientist and a journalist. They will receive the prize for their outstanding contribution to increasing public awareness and understanding of science. The winners will each receive EUR 12,500. The prize succeeds the NWO's Eureka Prizes and the Academy's Van Walree Prize. The prize is sponsored by the Van Walree Fund.

Carlos Daganzo has published 143 Scopus-registered papers on transportation research since 1975. His research has a very wide scope, from public transport planning to traffic operations. More important, his papers show a consistent style: a simple innovative idea, with important consequences. Since they are difficult to read, you will not read all papers yourself. During the course, his ideas will be presented.

After this course, the student is able to:

- read a difficult paper and extract the underlying principle;
- work with several of the innovative and influential ideas put forward by Daganzo;
- stretch a simple idea, apply it and present the consequences;
- (hopefully) value simplicity in modelling.
